The program includes:

Eligibility Requirements:

Candidates Must:

1. Be in good standing as a law student at an ABA accredited law school, or be a recent law school graduate of an ABA accredited law school;
2. Demonstrate a record of academic achievement;
3. Have a sincere interest in Harrity and practicing patent law; and
4. Have a background in a technical field (e.g., B.S. in Electrical Engineering, B.S. in Computer Science, B.S. in Mechanical Engineering or like such).

Program Application Process:

Applications will be accepted from February 1, 2019 through April 30, 2019. Candidates must submit a completed application (see attached), a personal statement expressing their interest in pursuing a career in the patent field, as well as their resume. Please note participants are responsible for their own lodging and transportation.
